Focused Revision List – IGCSE Geography 0460

Paper 1 will test your knowledge and understanding of the topics that we have covered in class since the beginning of year 10. There are three major key themes 1. Population & Settlement 2. Natural Environments and 3. Economic Development.

You will be answering three questions from a choice of any questions from 1-4 even though there are six on the paper. Question 1 & 2 are on Population & Settlement. Question 3&4 are on Natural Environments and 5 & 6 are on Economic Development. ***As we have not started Economic Development, you should not attempt questions 5 or 6.***

You have 1 hour 45 minutes to complete the paper, which equates to about 35 minutes per question. You will need to bring a blue or black pen, ruler and calculator to the exam. You will also have a resource booklet with photos, maps and graphs to use with some of the questions. ***Read the instructions on the front cover of the exam paper carefully.***

Theme 1 – Population & Settlement (Questions 1 & 2)		
Can you define birth rates & death rates and how they are measured?	n/a	
Can you define literacy rates, GDP PPP, life expectancy?	n/a	
Can you explain why some places have high population density and others have low?		
Can you explain the issues caused by over and under population?		
Can you remember what push and pull factors are and how they can impact on your migration case studies (international & internal).		
Can you recognise the different shapes of settlement patterns (linear, nucleated, dispersed)?		
Can you remember your case studies about Favelas and rural to urban migration in Brazil?		
Can you explain how traffic congestion can impact upon HIC cities?		
Can you explain how conflicts can arise in urban areas over land use changes?		
Theme 2 – Natural Environments (Questions 3 & 4)		
Can you remember all your coastal processes of erosion, transportation & deposition?		
Can you define hydraulic action, Corrasion, Corrosion and Attrition?		
Can you describe and explain how coral reefs are formed and their characteristics?		

Can you explain the formation of your erosional and depositional coastal landforms (caves, arches, stacks, headlands, bays and beaches).		
Can you recognise different coastal protection methods and explain how they help to fight against coastal erosion.		
Can you explain why equatorial / desert climates exist?		
Can you explain the causes and effects of deforestation on countries around the world and their people?		
Can you explain the different layers of the rainforest?		

You will have worked out that some areas of the course are not going to be tested in the January Mock examination namely earthquakes & volcanoes as well as rivers. You should read over the revision list for Paper 2 though as there are some knowledge based questions that you have to know that it.
