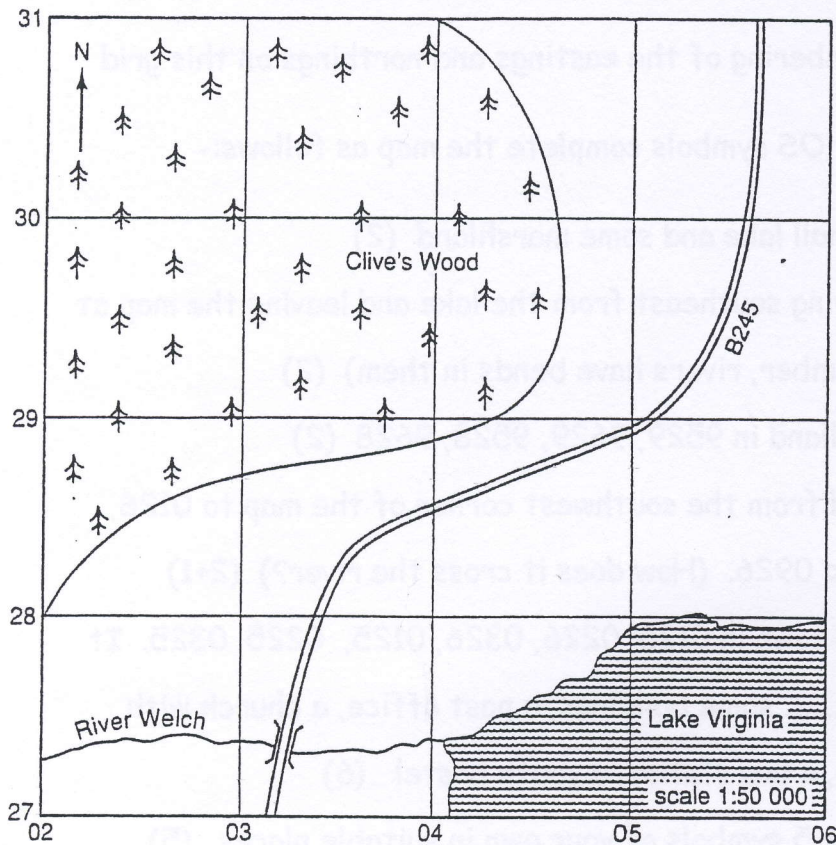


# GRID REFERENCES

- 1 Give a 4-figure grid reference to locate Lake Virginia .....
- 2 Give two 4-figure grid references to locate the northern part of Clive's Wood.

- 3 Give the 4-figure grid reference for the bridge, which carries the B245 road over the River Welch. ....
- 4 In grid square 0528, mark in a bridle path which joins the B245 road to Lake Virginia.
- 5 In grid square 0428, mark on the south side of the road a parking area and toilets.
- 6 In grid square 0227, south of the river, locate a camping area.

### Activities

1. Finish off the numbering of the eastings and northings on this grid

2. Using the correct OS symbols complete the map as follows:-

- 9727 - a small lake and some marshland (2)
- a river flowing southeast from the lake and leaving the map at 0421 (remember, rivers have bends in them) (2)
- Mixed woodland in 9529, 9629, 9528, 9628 (2)
- A main road from the southwest corner of the map to 0126, then east to 0926. (How does it cross the river?) (2+1)
- Add a small town in 0126, 0226, 0326, 0125, 0225, 0325. It must have ..... some buildings, a post office, a church with spire, a pub, a bus station, a youth hostel (6)
- Add at least 5 symbols of your own in suitable places. (5)
