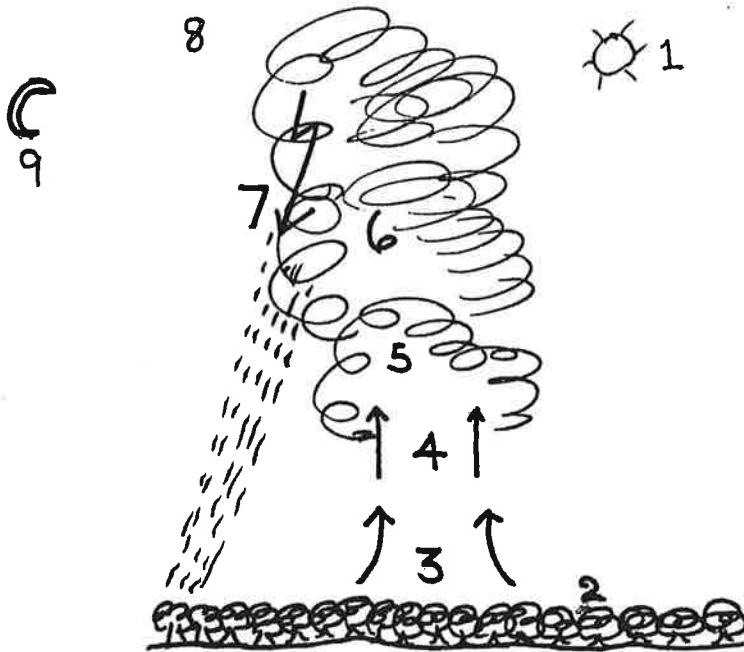


## Daily weather ~ Convictional Rainfall

Draw a line from each label to the correct number on the diagram



### Labels

- Air near ground gets warm
- Water vapour condenses and clouds form
- Sun is high in sky
- Clouds get bigger and darker (cumulo-nimbus rain clouds)
- Torrential rain, thunder and lightning
- Water vapour carried up into sky
- Storm ends and sky clears
- Water from vegetation rises and evaporates
- Sun sets, night is clear and humid

## How the trees and soil work together

Add these labels to the diagram in an appropriate place

### Labels

- foliage protects soil from heavy rainfall
- roots hold soil together
- leaves decay (rot) to form **humus** which provides **nutrients**
- leaf fall
- roots take up water containing nutrients
- oxygen
- water evaporated
