In addition to SILVER describe why at least four of the indicators that you looked at in Task 1 indicate that Nepal is an LIC and explain one piece of data where Nepal scores better.
Chapter 3 Who are the Sherpa?	Give some basic reasons why the Sherpa are important people when it comes to climbing Mount Everest.	In addition to BRONZE, describe what Sherpas do for a living and then explain why they are important to Nepal and visitors.	In additional to SILVER, describe the risks involved to the Sherpa (Disposable Man video).
