

Problems?

China's **one-child** policy was introduced in **1979** although it was preceded by other policies to keep the population down from 1971 onwards

China's population is **1.3bn** (2009) and projected to reach **1.7bn** by 2050.

Those who back the **one-child policy** claim it would now be **1.7bn** had it not been in place.

336m abortions in China since 1979

222m sterilisations have taken place in China since 1979

56% of Chinese parents said they wanted a second child if it were legal

9.5m children per woman (1960) would result in an additional 3m births every year

China's workforce shrinks by 3m last year

4.77 children per woman (1960) would result in an additional 1.64 children per woman in 2010

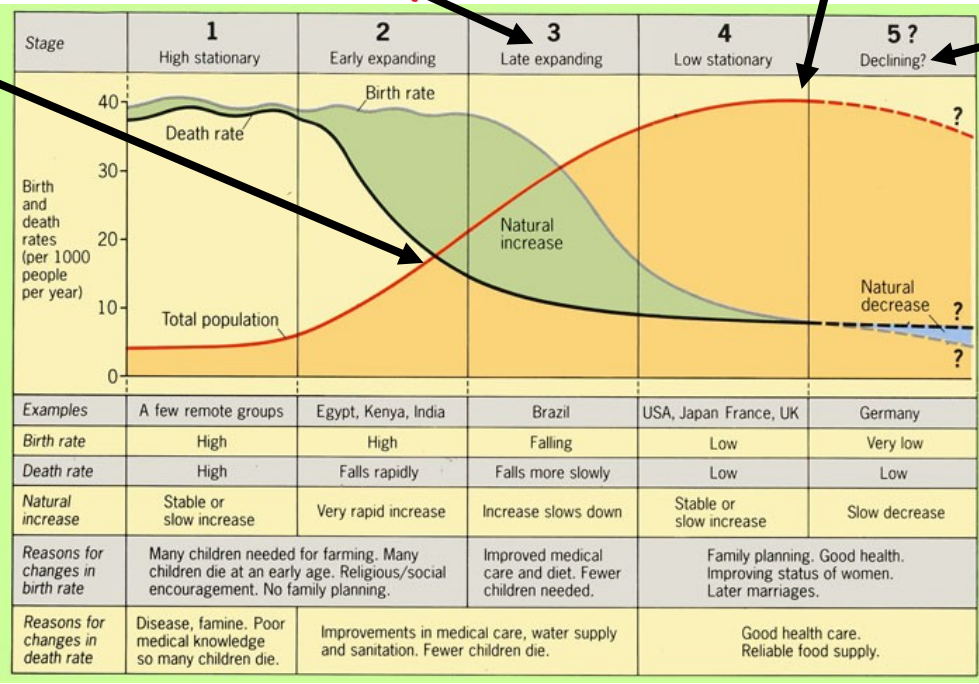
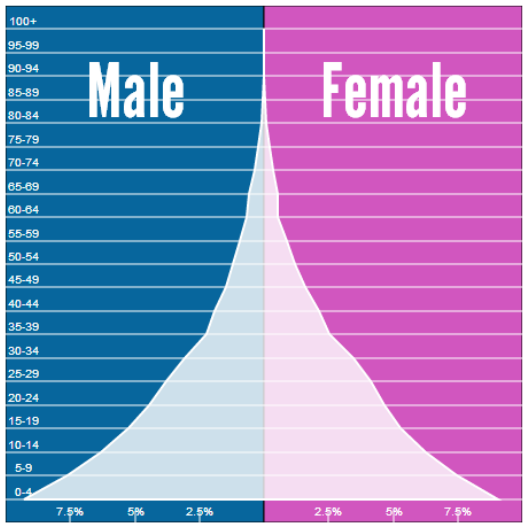
There will be an additional 140m jobs needed by 2020

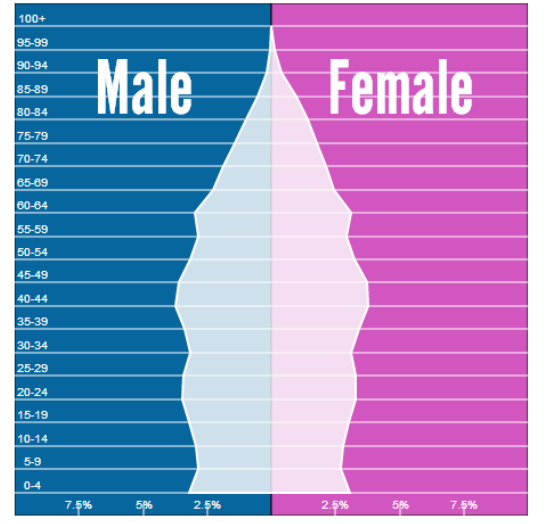

Population: **62.066.000**



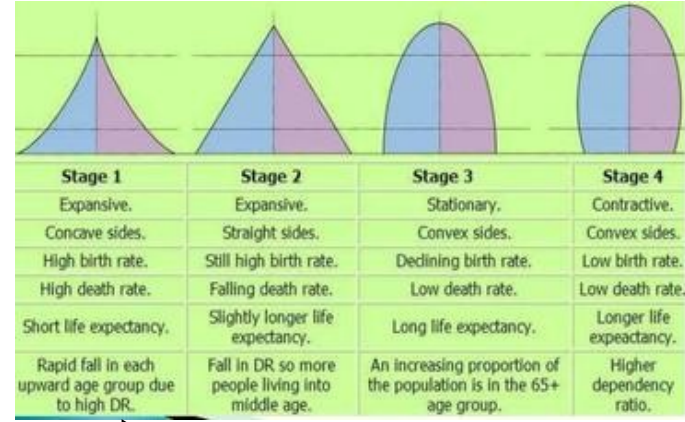
